Overall, the excursion to Hastinapur was a resounding success and an enriching experience for all.



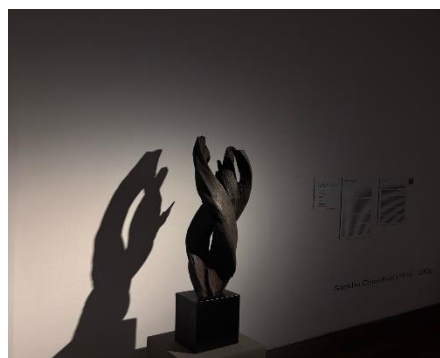


Educational Visit to Kiran Nadar Museum of Art – ‘Purvaee’ Exhibition
